BIRKENHEAD LAKE ESTATES	Wilderness FSR
BLACKWATER (TO BIRKENHEAD LAKE)	Public Use FSR Recommend 4WD, drive with caution
BRANDYWINE (TO THE MEADOWS)	Wilderness FSR Seasonally deactivated 4WD access only Access Brandywine FSR via Callaghan Nordic Venue road
BRITANNIA/ FURRY CREEK	Industrial Use FSR Closed
BROHM RIDGE (CHEEKYE)	Wilderness FSR Seasonally deactivated No vehicular access past last gate (to prevent irreparable damage to alpine by vehicular traffic); foot access only after that point Recommend 4WD, drive with caution
CALLAGHAN EAST	Industrial Use FSR Open
CALLAGHAN LAKE	Industrial Use FSR Seasonally deactivated 4WD access only Closed to all motorized vehicles each year from November 1 to May 15 under section
